



You have the right to receive a “Good Faith Estimate” explaining how much your medical care will cost.

Under the law, health care providers need to give **patients who don't have insurance or who are not using insurance** an estimate of their bill for medical items and services.

- You have the right to receive a “Good Faith Estimate” for the total expected cost of any non-emergency items or services. This includes related costs like medical tests, prescription drugs, equipment, and hospital fees.
- Make sure your health care provider gives you a “Good Faith Estimate” in writing a least 1 business day before your medical service or item. You can also ask your health care provider, and any other provider you choose, for a “Good Faith Estimate” before you schedule an item or service.
- If you receive a bill that is a least \$400 more than your “Good Faith Estimate”, you can dispute the bill.
- Make sure to save a copy or picture of your “Good Faith Estimate”.
